## **SPA UPDATE:**

The spa will remain open through the fall months while the Board continues to evaluate its monthly usage. If you're one of the people who enjoy having this feature available, then the Board encourages you to use it often.

#### **GUTTER CLEANING:**

Each year the Association contracts to have the gutters cleaned. This is part of our maintenance, but it is scheduled later in the season after a majority of the leaves have fallen. The Board has approved a bid and the work is scheduled to begin sometime in January 2012.

#### **LANDSCAPE UPDATE:**

Our new landscaping company has only been on the job for about 7 weeks and they have made a big difference. They have divided our development into 4 sections. One section will be addressed each week. This results in all areas seeing

pruning once a month. While one area is being pruned extensively, the other areas will be checked for needed correction that can not wait until their time.

The Board has approved changes to our entrances. They will be re-planting these areas with perinneal plants that will not need to be changed every quarter. We chose some color variations that should look very nice. Let us know your opinion when you see the change.

We had many conversations about tree maintenance with our prior landscaper, but could never come to terms with them on a viable plan. We have initiated a plan with our new landscaper that should begin soon. We will be removing some of the trees that are hazards and some that have outlived their usefulness. We will be replacing them where it can be done.

## **HOLIDAY REMINDERS:**

Verona is always festive during the holidays as many people take a lot of time and care with their decorations and outdoor lights. When you decorate, please remember that nothing can be placed on the rail or corner posts of the second floor patio decks. All exterior decorations need to be removed for the season by January 15<sup>th</sup>, so please plan to have them removed by that date. Also, please be sure to park your vehicles inside your garage (to its capacity) and leave the open spaces available for family and friends who visit. Your thoughtfulness is greatly appreciated.

## **COMMON AREA REMINDER:**

Please be aware that Common Area is *Common* Area and is not to be used as personal property. Please do not place plants, pots, and other items in the common area. This can create problems for our landscapers and any other vendors. Any item in the common area could be lost or damaged. Please keep these items on your front step or in your patio area.

We have new landscapers now and they seem to be more responsive than our last ones. Please give them a chance to perform. Do not take it upon yourself to cut trees or shrubs. If you feel this needs to be done, please contact Homeowner Association Services. Thank you for your cooperation.

## **2012 BUDGET UPDATE:**

The 2012 budget has been approved. We were able to maintain the same assessment as 2011. You should have already received a large, white envelope containing your complete budget package. Please read these documents over so you can see how your assessment is used.
