**VOTING RESULTS**

Thank you to everyone who sent in their ballot and also to all who attended this important meeting. Also on the ballot was to vote on the Annual Tax Resolution and the purchase of Earthquake Insurance.

Board Election: This year there were 4 homeowners running for 3 open positions. Members Madhav Kondle, Srinivas Kumar and Candice Mateo were elected and will serve a two-year term.

Federal Tax Resolution: The Federal Tax Resolution did pass. The approval of a resolution which authorizes the Board to transfer any year-end net operating income to the reserve fund, or to be used to off-set operating expenses per IRS Ruling 70-604 and 75-371.

Earthquake Insurance: The membership approved to obtain Earthquake Insurance. After the discussion, the Board approved to purchase a policy with a higher deductible of 20% deductible; a premium of \$78,130.

A special thank you to outgoing Board members, Diane Birchell, Don Clark and Wayne Watari for their time serving on the Board.

**PETS**

Pet owners are reminded to pick up after your pet. Please be sure to pick up your pet waste and dispose properly in your trash. Also, please do not leave pet food and water outside, this attracts unwanted pests including raccoons, skunks, etc.

**All parking permits must be displayed  
at all times including weekends 24 hours a day, seven days a week.**

Any vehicle without a permit will be towed without notice at the expense of the vehicle owner. As a reminder, residents that do not require a permit, you are still required to register your vehicle which includes providing a valid DMV registration that shows both the resident and property address. If you have any questions or have received a notice, please contact HAS immediately to resolve the issue.

A resident using a visitor pass is prohibited. Misuse of the visitor permits or resident permits will result in a hearing, fine and the possibility of your vehicle being towed.

The cost for a replacement permit for both resident and visitor is \$25.

**PEDESTRIANS VS. WHEELS**

PLEASE SLOW D-O-W-N when driving into or around the Association. Use caution when walking in the evenings, especially when crossing streets. And drivers, watch out for cyclists and skaters. Also, please do not ride bikes, skateboards and scooters on the sidewalks. Sidewalks are for pedestrians and it can be very difficult to slow down in time to avoid hitting someone strolling on the same sidewalk where you are racing your bike or skateboard.

**PESTS AND SNAKES**

It's that time of the year when snakes may be more visible. Snakes such as king, gopher and garden snakes are good for the community. It eats the rats, gophers, moles, voles, etc. Also, as a reminder that leaving bait stations for rodent are prohibited and against the law to place these bait stations in the common areas.
